





## **Step 1** — **Mounting right side (Components)**



- Base
- Right side panel
- Screws M3 10mm (Black) (2x)
- M3 Nuts (2x)

### Step 2 — Mounting right side






- Take the base and insert two M3 nuts.
- (i) In case you can't press the nuts in, don't use excessive force. Rotate the nut until it falls in place.
- Connect the base with the right side panel.
- Insert the M3 10mm screws through both holes in the right side. Start tightening until you reach the M3 nut. Tighten both screws all the way.


# Step 3 — Mounting left side (components)



- Left side panel
- Screws M3 10mm (Black) (2x)
- M3 Nuts (2x)

### Step 4 — Mounting left side






- Take the base and insert two M3 nuts.
- (i) In case you can't press the nuts in, don't use excessive force. Rotate the nut until it falls in place.
- Connect the base with the left side panel.
- Insert the M3 10mm screws through both holes in the right side. Start tightening until you reach the M3 nut. Tighten both screws all the way.

- Screws M3 10mm (Black) (2x)
- M3 Nuts (2x)


#### **Step 6** — **Mounting bottom front panel**






- Take the left side panel and the right side panel and insert the two M3 nuts.
- (i) In case you can't press the nuts in, don't use excessive force. Rotate the nut until it falls in place.
- Connect the left side panel and the right side panel with the bottom front panel.
- Insert the M3 10mm screws through both holes in the right side. Start tightening until you reach the M3 nut. Tighten both screws all the way.

#### **Step 7** — **Mounting top front panel (components)**




- Top front panel
- Screws M3 10mm (Black) (2x)
- M3 Nuts (2x)

#### **Step 8** — **Mounting top front panel**



- Take the left side panel and the right side panel and insert the two M3 nuts.
- in case you can't press the nuts in, don't use excessive force. Rotate the nut until it falls in place.
- Connect the left side panel and the right side panel with the top front panel.
- Insert the M3 10mm screws through both holes in the right side. Start tightening until you reach the M3 nut. Tighten both screws all the way.
